



Coronation Weekend - The Big Lunch: Sunday 7th May

The Parish Council and Holmes Chapel Partnership are working together for the village celebration of the Coronation. The main features are:

St Luke's usual 9am and 10.30am services, with special prayers for the King & Queen.

From 11am, London Road will be closed through the village centre to prepare for the Big Lunch; the road will reopen at 5pm

- Tables will be set up in the street, but you will need to bring your own chairs as well as a picnic – no BBQs or drinking glasses please.
- The church will be open to the public from 12 noon until 3.30pm, but no food please inside the building.

From 12.30pm, St Luke's bells will ring out for half-an-hour.

At 1pm the Town Crier will officially open The Big Lunch:

- Everyone is invited to enjoy a picnic with friends and family in the village centre until 3.30pm when the event closes and clear-up begins.
- Picnic rugs may be spread in the churchyard but, for safety, no BBQs, drinking glasses or bottles please.
- There will be entertainment and music with a brass band, roaming magician and balloon artist here helping us celebrate this momentous occasion.
- The brass band will play in the churchyard (or in church if the weather is bad)
- The Church Hall will be used if needed for the picnic lunch as a wet weather alternative.
